## **Industrial Owners Council**

Develop and implement methods to improve the supply of trained and certified craftpersons. Assure appropriate training programs are available for job-entry and on-going skills improvement throughout a career that align with owners needs.

## **Legal Advisory/Legislative Committee**

A forum for construction professionals to discuss current legal and legislative trends, changes and issues.
